

## P. BUCKLEY MOSS FOUNDATION GRANTS APPLICATION

The P. Buckley Moss Foundation for Children's Education has grants available *up* to \$1,000 to be awarded in 2025 to educators who need assistance to further their 2026-2027 program goals.

Applications may be made for a grant up to \$1,000 for a project within schools serving <u>all</u> children (including students who learn differently) pre-K - 12, that integrates the arts into educational programs. The purpose for this grant is to aid and support teachers who wish to establish or maintain an effective learning tool using the visual arts within the school day. The grant money awarded is **specifically** for acquisition of visual art supplies. Examples are, paint, clay, modelling materials, tiles, markers, pencils and paper, to name a few. Items that are **not** eligible for funding include cameras, copiers, kilns, transportation fees, teacher's salaries. The grant is intended to provide hands-on opportunities for the students to explore art in a variety of applications.

Applications will only be considered if all requested information is included.
